Dear Families:

Welcome back to the Robin Room after Spring Break. We hope you have renewed enthusiasm and are ready to embrace the remainder of the school year.

We will begin this month by talking about spring weather in Wyoming. Some weather projects and simple experiments are planned for this unit. We may tie in The Three Little Pigs to compare the force of our breath with the force of the wind. Letters related to this theme are W and U. We will also have vocabulary words beginning with R and E for recycling and Earth Day. See our plans for this theme below.

The Robins will be participating in an **Earth Day** and recycling theme. We will be talking about taking care of the earth and the reason for Earth Day, which is always on April 22nd. Please send **rinsed** soda cans, **rinsed** milk jugs, and water bottles to school where we will sort them and distribute them among our students. If the weather permits, we will have a walking field trip to the Meals on Wheels (MOW) parking lot on Thursday, April 19th, to sort and deposit our recycled items. This activity will provide our students with an opportunity to do some practical number identification and some interpretation of the signs on the bins at MOW. Permission slips will be available to fill out for this activity starting the second week of April. As always, you are welcome to walk with us and to help our students sort their recyclable items.
