Greetings Dragonfly Families,

Welcome back and Happy New Year! Thank you for donations of snack, supplies, time and support for our school year so far! We appreciate everything....and can always use more snack donations. As we begin this new year you'll see us in a **winter** theme. Our winter explorations include fiction and non-fiction literature about seasons, cold weather, snow, ice, and animals and people in winter. This will be reflected in our activities this month. Our new letters are **M**-mitten, **I**-ice, ice crystals (snowflakes) and **Q**-quilt. Talking with your preschooler about their day is beneficial to strengthen their learning and foster their communication skills. We often read a story or poem over and over together at school. This helps with comprehension. Ask your preschooler to tell you a story they learned at school. This month one of our guided reading stories is "The Mitten" by Jan Brett. That's a good one to ask us about! If you haven't brought in your family and friend picture collage, please do. Our family and friend book is growing and it is a favorite!

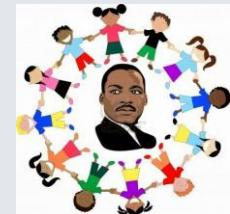
